Field Monitor Guidelines

- Field Monitor is the authority for the field, they identify with the officials who they are ahead of the game
- They can remove any fan with the backing of the officials
- Overseeing change of games, making sure that nothing happens such as a verbal exchange with officials, other teams, or parents.
- Change in field monitor during the game day, new Field Monitor must notify the officials ahead of the next game
- This year with the centralized games DRSA will be requiring parents to volunteer as Field monitors, it will no longer just fall on the coaches and Football Director to monitor the games
- When JYFA board is present, they will enforce any rulings by the officials along with support of field monitor
- If there is a prior week's ejection of a coach or player, the field monitor will be notified and help the officials keep track of the individual(s) not participating in the game
- If there is an ejection from the official during the game, the field monitor makes sure that they are properly escorted away from the field
